Radio: we participate with the society spreading mining

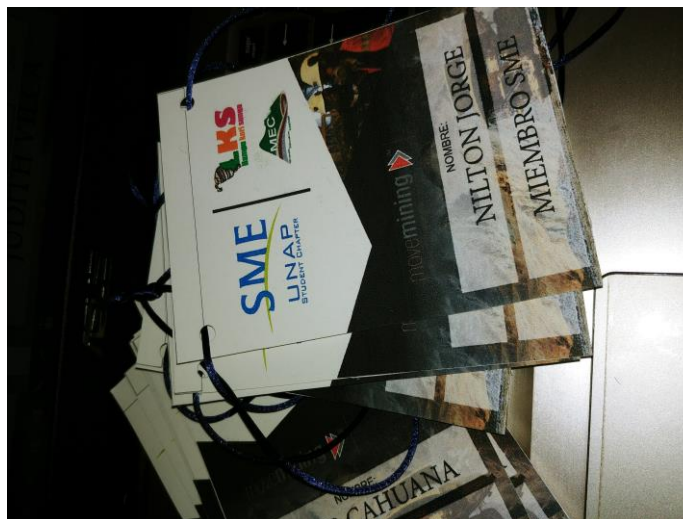
Social networks: We publish positive news about responsible mining
